Travelling by bus and train within the Network West Midlands area (16-18 Photocard)

Students who live in the Network West Midlands area can apply for a 16-18 Photocard which allows them to buy season tickets, Direct Debit tickets and cash fares on buses and trains at child rates. To be eligible students need to be between 16 and 18 years old on the 1 September and live in a household where council tax is payable in either Birmingham, Coventry, Dudley, Sandwell, Solihull, Walsall or Wolverhampton Council.

The card can be obtained by applying online to www.networkwestmidlands.com

To complete the online application the student will also require valid email address and a digital passport style photograph.

Train Tickets from outside NWM area

Students living in Worcestershire do not qualify for a NWM 16-18 Photocard, however, if travelling by train they may benefit from purchasing a West Midlands Railway Student Season Ticket, which offers 50% discount on the cost of travel with WMR.

Alternatively, a 16-17 Saver is a young person's rail card that entitles students (up until their 18th birthday) to receive a 50% discount off all train travel and can be used with the Trainline app so that a student can pay electronically each day for their ticket. College transport

The college provides alternative travel solutions for some students who live in areas where there is little or no suitable public transport. At present chartered coaches and college minibuses travel into college from Bridgnorth, Cleobury Mortimer (via Bewdley), Bromsgrove, south Birmingham (Longbridge, Northfield and Rubery) and west Worcestershire (Martley, Great Witley and Stourport). A new route from Wolverhampton is being introduced from September 2021.

The cost for all of the routes from September 2022 is as follows: £150 per term. Therefore, in year 12 the cost will total £450. In year 13 the cost will total £300, meaning no payment in sixth term during exams.
